Proposed Constitutional Amendment

Question: Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to allow the General Assembly to temporarily adopt new congressional districts to restore fairness in the upcoming elections, while ensuring Virginia's standard redistricting process resumes for all future redistricting after the 2030 census?

Saturday, April 18, 2026: Last day to vote Early In-Person.

Friday, April 10, 2026: Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail, fax or online. Applications must be received by the Floyd County Registrar Office by 4:30 p.m.

Friday, April 24, 2026: Absentee ballots must be postmarked by April 21, 2026 and received by the Floyd County Registrar Office no later than 12:00 noon EST on April 24th to be counted.

Tuesday, April 14, 2026: Last day to register *to vote or change your voter* registration information for this election.

Mailed voter registration application must be received in this office postmarked on or before the deadline.

Same Day Registration is now available, however, Same Day Registrants must vote a provisional ballot which will be considered and cast after the election, if accepted.
